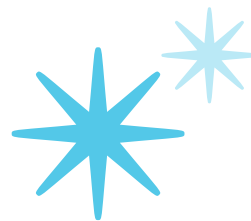


## California Literacy Coaches and Reading Specialists Grant Program

The California Department of Education has awarded the Literacy Coaches and Reading Specialists Educator Training Competitive Grant, also known as the Literacy Coaches and Reading Specialists (LCRS) program, to eligible sites with the purpose of providing training for educators and to support the goal of all California students reading by third grade by 2026.

Grant recipients may use funds to:

- Develop school literacy programs
- Train literacy coaches and specialists
- Implement interventions for students

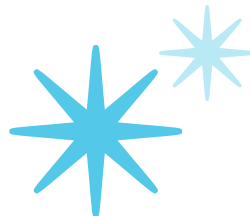

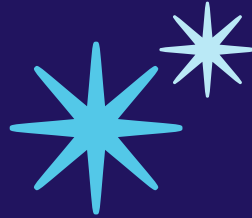
