



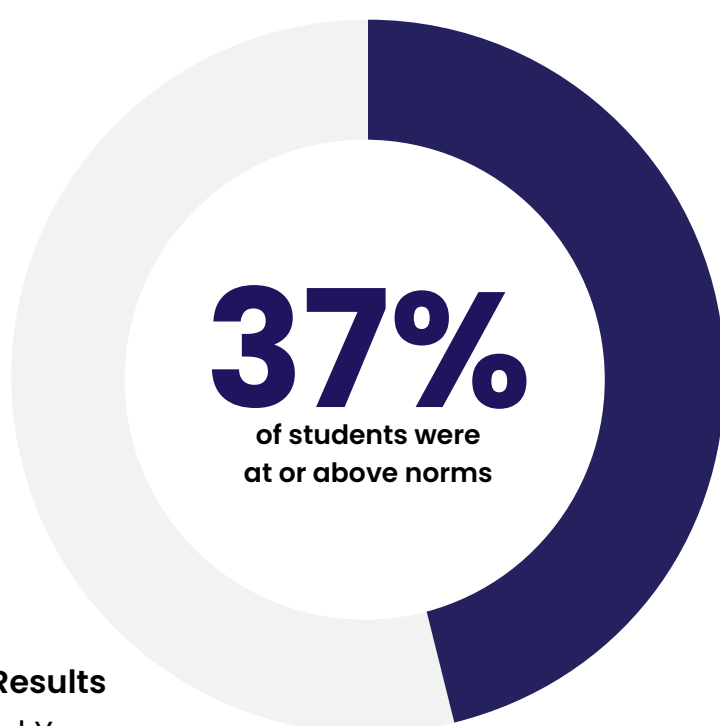

The Problem

Literacy Curriculum in the Waterford School District

While using a balanced literacy approach, educators in Michigan's Waterford School District were not seeing results accelerating students' foundational reading skills.

2019–2020 School Year

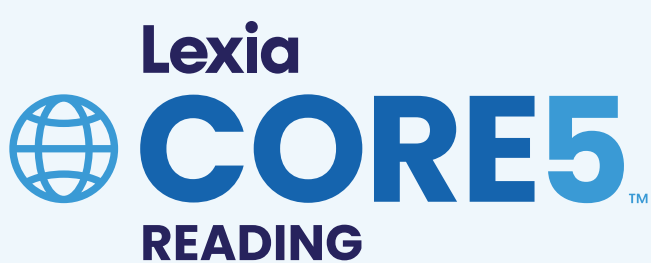

Implement Lexia® Core5® Reading

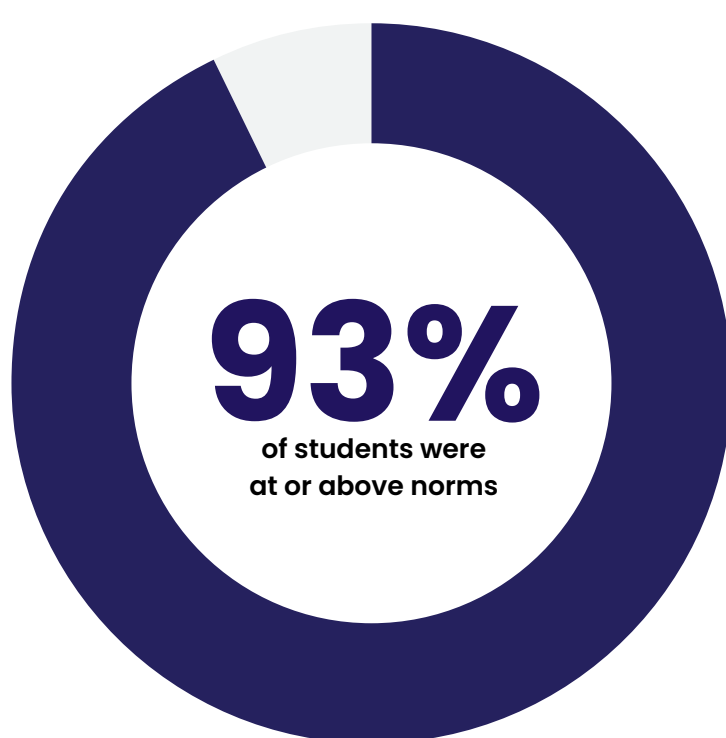

The Rand Study

The standardized effect of 0.11 is equivalent to 54% of Core5 students outperforming the comparison group median on the spring 2022 reading assessment.
