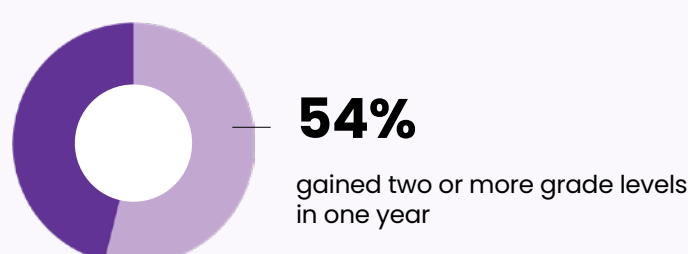
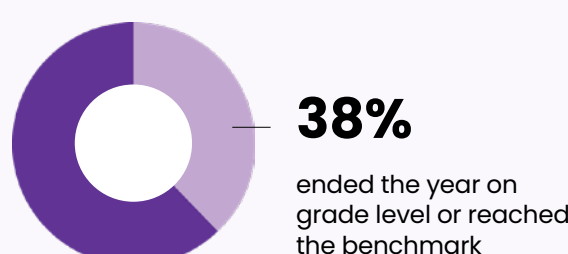
Students Working at or Above Grade Level
