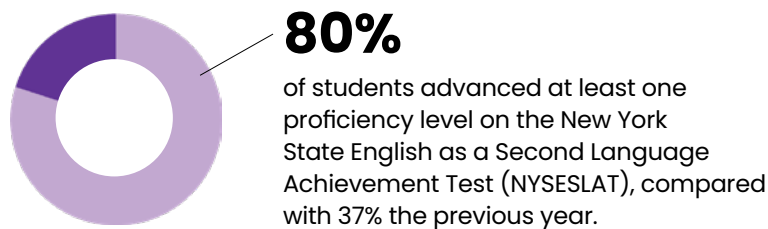


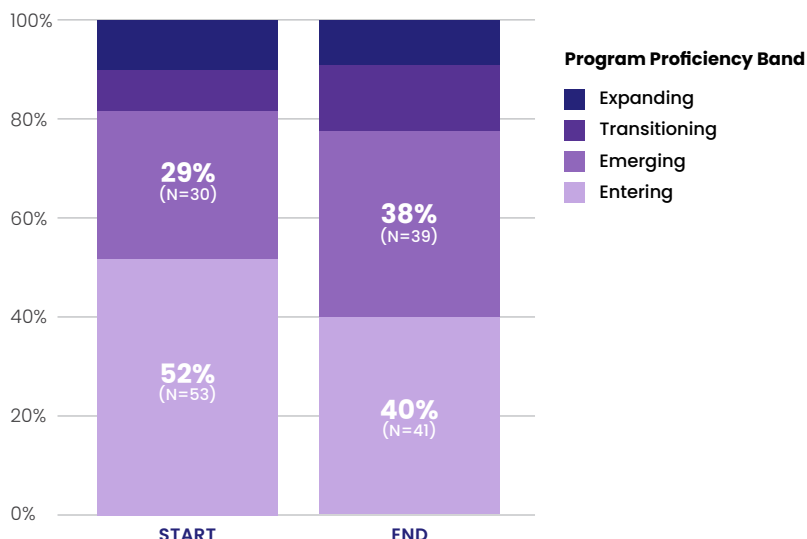
New York Schools Are Driving Immediate Gains for Multilingual Learners
