

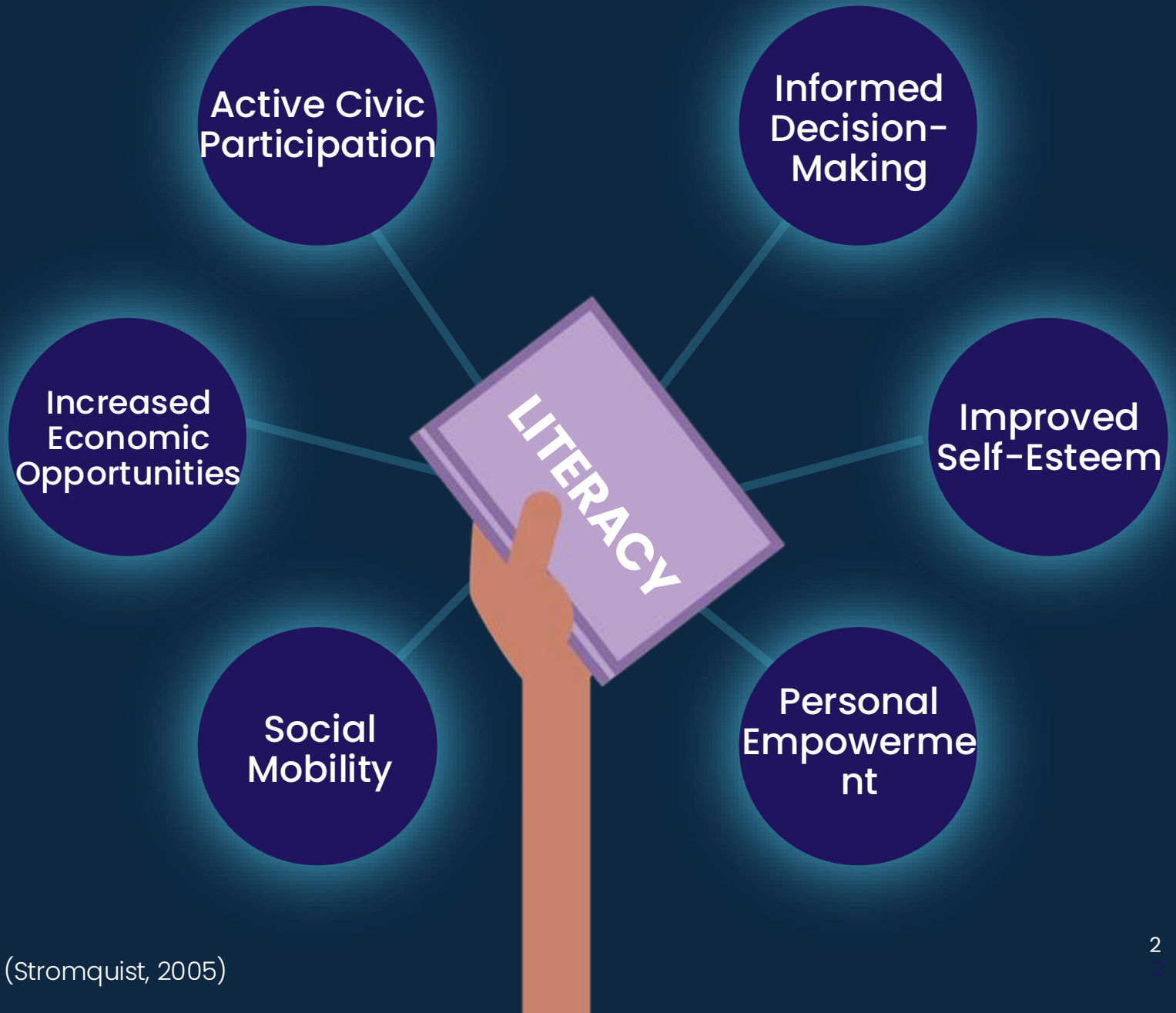

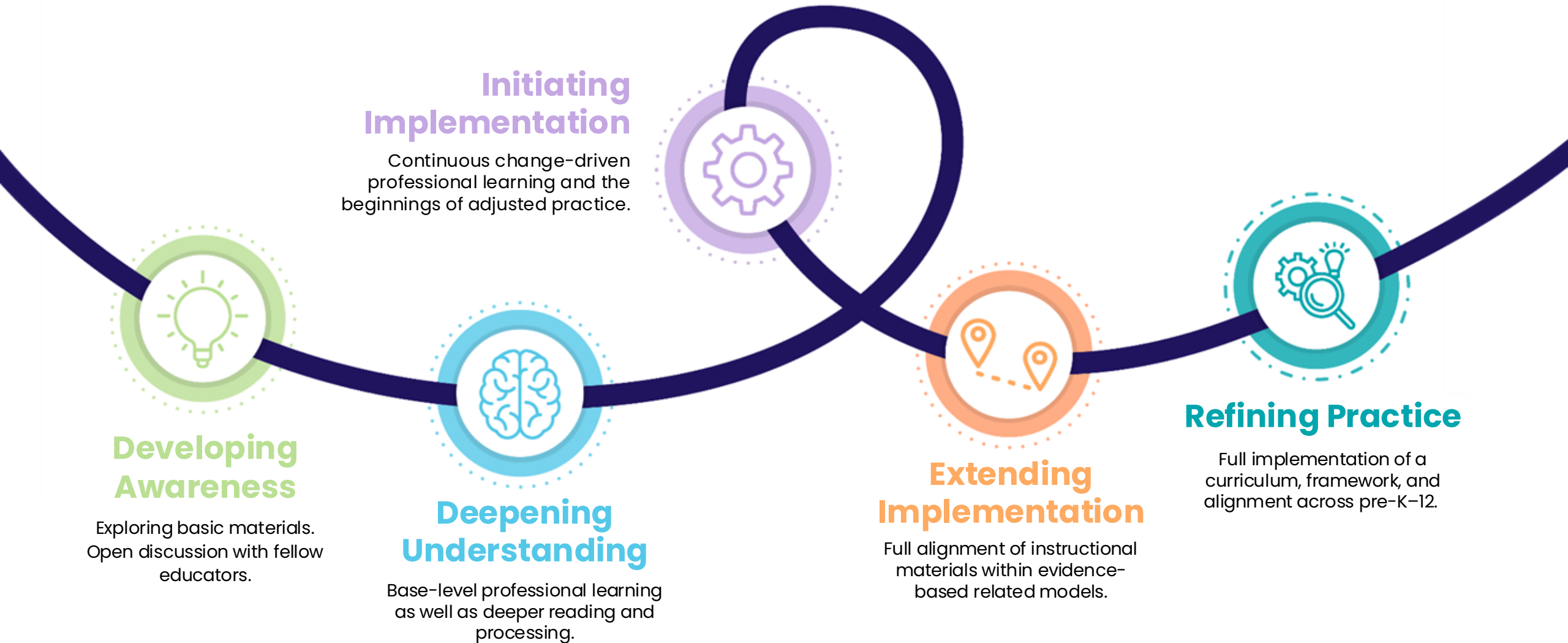

Implementation science seeks **to close the gap between what is known** about literacy acquisition **and the implementation of this knowledge in the classroom**, often referred to as the KNOW-DO gap. This gap can be closed by **identifying and addressing barriers** to the use of evidence-based practices.”

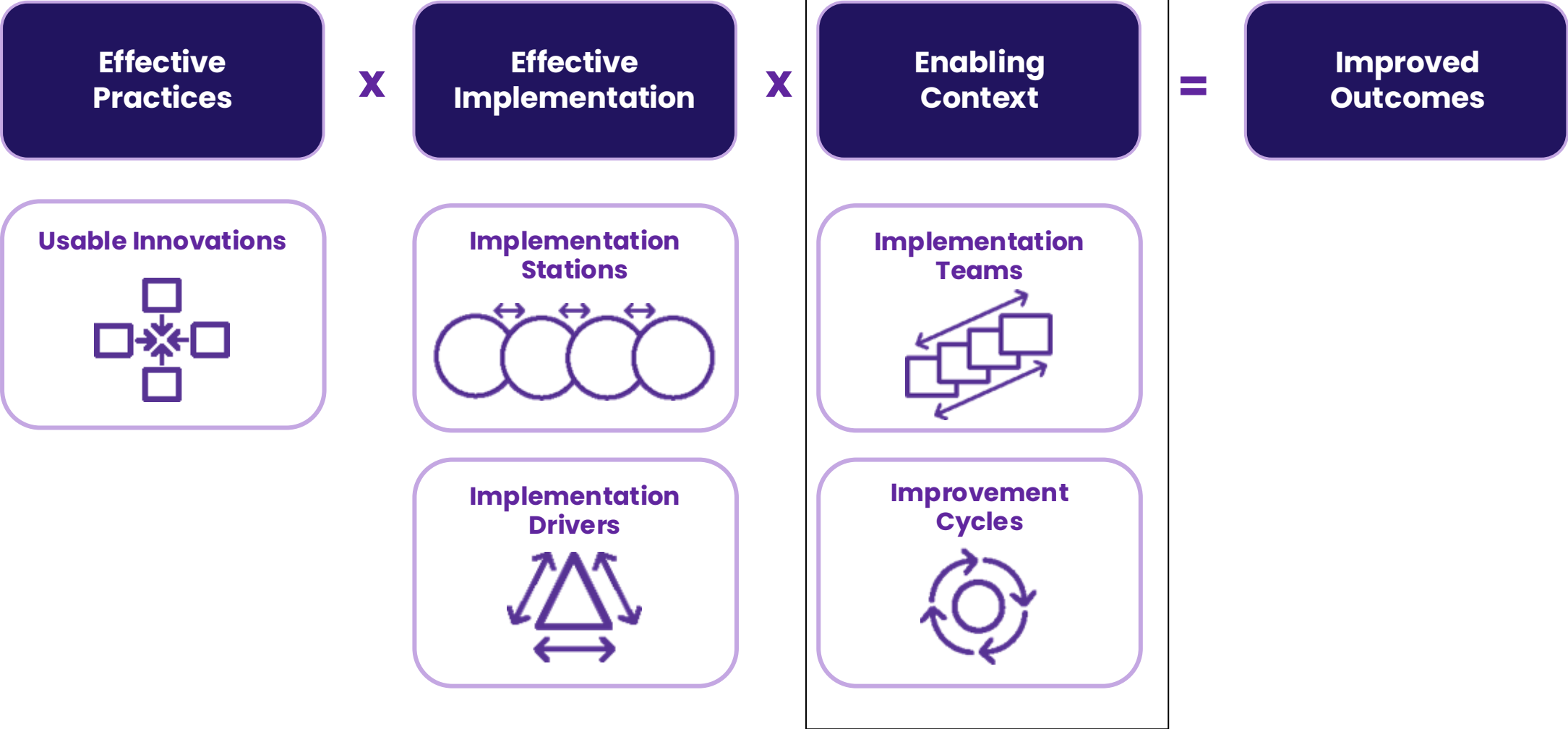

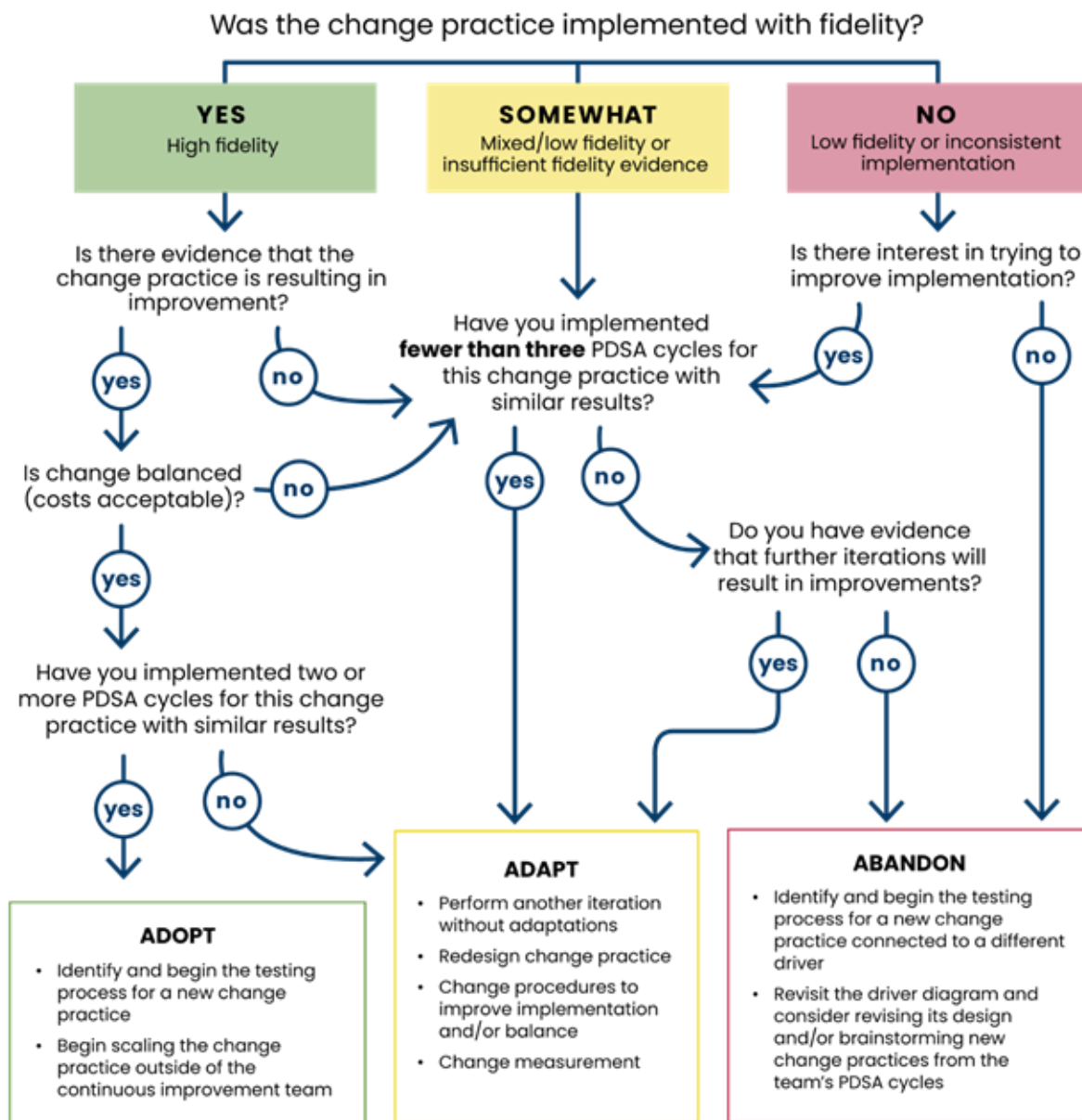
The reduction or elimination of inappropriate, ineffective, or potentially harmful programs to ensure that limited resources are used effectively.

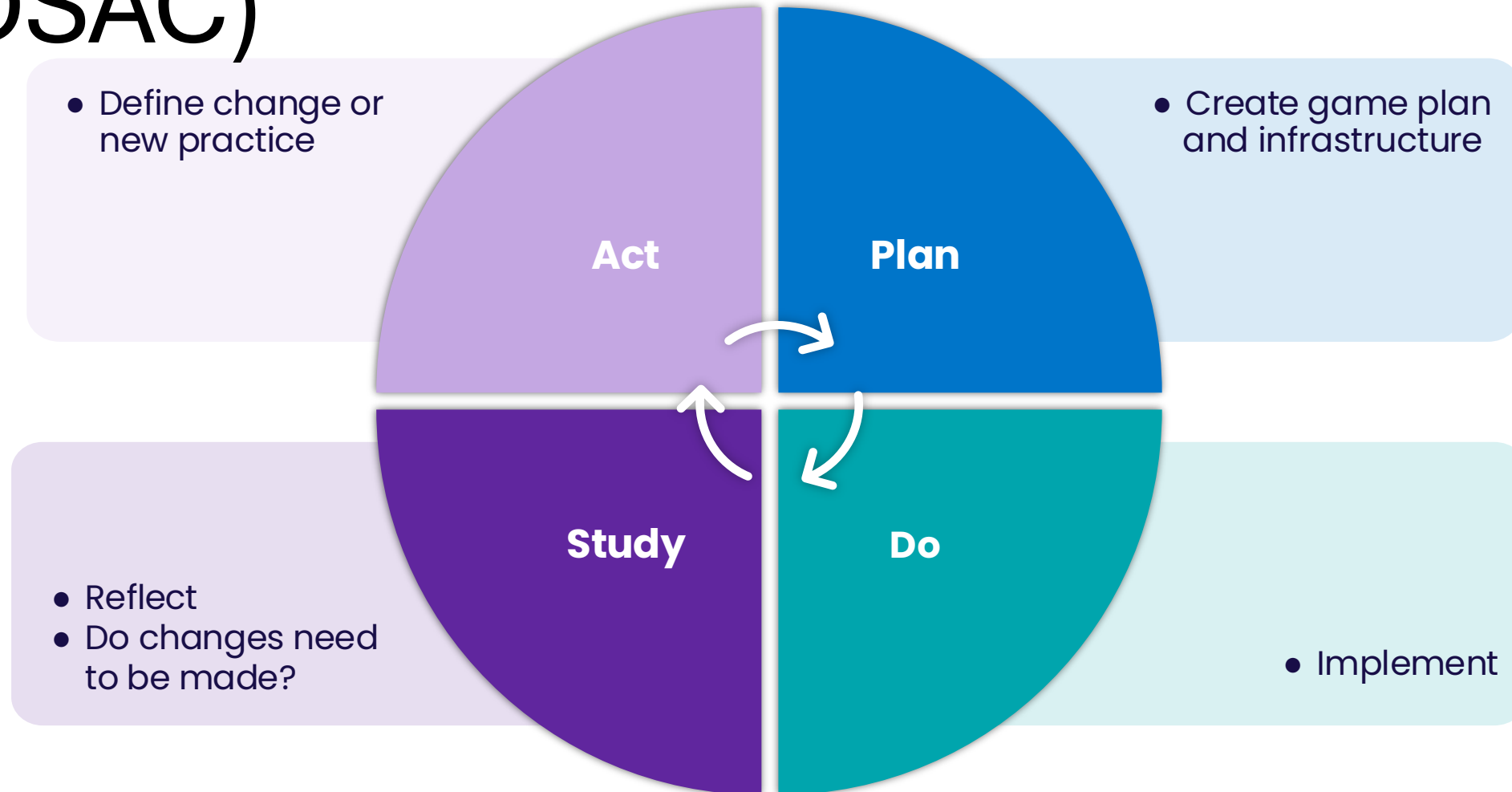


SISEP Formula and Framework
