Results for 1,328,951 Pre-K-5 U.S. students who used Core5 between 7/29/2024 and 5/25/2025. Students were considered to have used the online portion of Core5 with fidelity if they used the program for at least 20 weeks, met their weekly usage targets for 50% or more of those weeks, and started using the program before the end of 2024 or met benchmark. Data compiled and analyzed by the Lexia Research Team.
