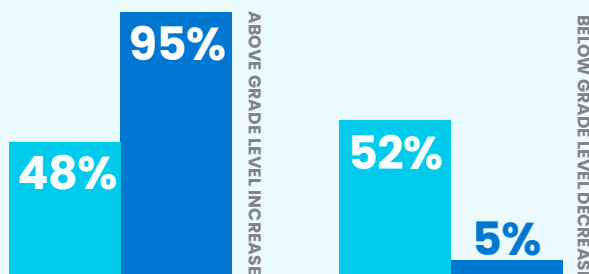
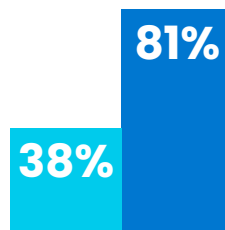
Lexia Boosts Charter Schools' Ability to Elevate Student Outcomes and Growth

Educators at more than **1,600** U.S. charter schools used Lexia® Core5® Reading during the 2023–2024 school year. When used with fidelity, Core5 helped increase students working at or above grade level from **38%** to **81%**.



The percentage of Somerset's K–2 students working in or above grade level in Core5 increased from **48%** to **95%** in less than one school year. The percentage of students working below grade level in Core5 declined from **52%** to **5%**.

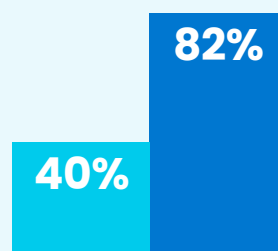

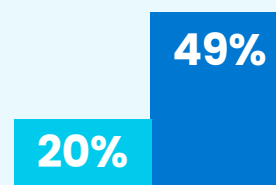

The percentage of students at Clay Charter Academy who were working at or above grade level increased from **40%** to **82%** in just six months.

Lexia Boosts Charter Schools' Ability to Empower Teachers

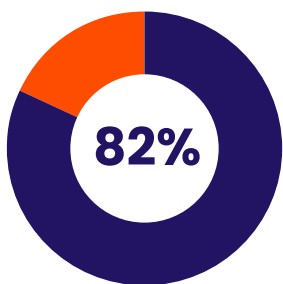
