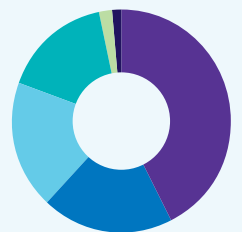

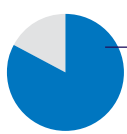

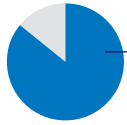
In public schools across NYC:



83% of students who met program usage advanced **at least one grade level** of material.¹



76% of students ended the year **at or above grade-level** materials.¹



86% of K–2 students who met program usage ended the year working on or above grade-level materials, up from 45% at the start of the year.¹

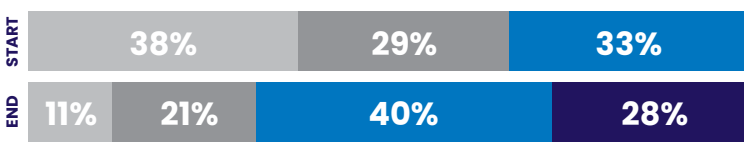
Equity Impact: Lexia use in Relevant Student Populations

Year-After-Year Success: NYC Case Study

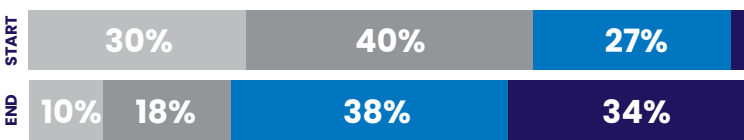
One NYC school using Core5 for two years saw students grow their literacy skills, no matter where students started.¹

2023–2024:



The percentage of students working below grade level dropped from **64% to 32%** in one year, while **28%** of students accelerated to **above-grade-level** skills.

2024–2025:



Continued gains: by the end of the second year, only **28% of students were working below grade level**, while **34% ended the year working on above-grade-level materials**.
