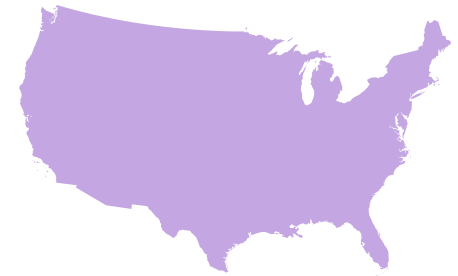

Alignment with ESSA standards

The federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires implementation of evidence-based interventions and programs, especially when using federal funds.

- ESSA defines "evidence-based" through four tiers (Tiers 1-4).
- The **gold standard is Tier 1, Strong Evidence** ("supported by at least one well-designed and well-implemented experimental study").
- Resources meeting Tier 1 criteria are designated as proven, reliable support for Title I and related programs.

Lexia® Core5® Reading for pre-K-5 and **Lexia® PowerUp Literacy®** for grades 6-12 both meet ESSA's Strong Evidence criteria via **10+ studies**.

Proven impact

Lexia research translates into measurable outcomes on assessments.

- **100+** special education students across **five schools** were tested on MAPS Growth Reading in the fall and spring. By the spring, Core5 users were **2x MORE LIKELY to be proficient readers** than control students.

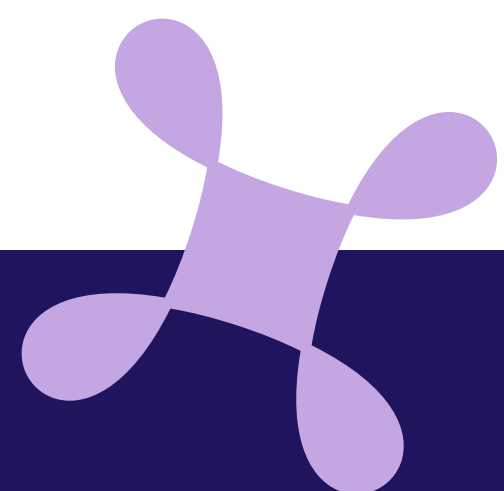
