CASE STUDY

Data Shows the Power of Individualized Literacy Instruction for Students in Chicago School: **Enrico Tonti Elementary School, Chicago, Illinois**

**OBJECTIVE**

District leaders will analyze a real-world example of individualized literacy instruction, reflect on key takeaways, and identify actionable insights they can share or apply within their own district to support data-driven, student-centered literacy practices.

GUIDING QUESTIONS

1. How did educators at Enrico Tonti Elementary leverage Lexia® Core5® Reading to drive long-term literacy gains, and what practices could you adapt to fit your district's context?
2. In what ways can data from individualized literacy platforms like Core5 inform instructional decisions and support differentiated learning across classrooms?

ACTIVITY
